THE PROPERTY

An extremely rare opportunity to acquire 38.1 acres of mature and semi mature woodland with lake within the Golden Triangle in West Sussex.

This attractive parcel of woodland lies to the west of Lurgashall and east of Fernhurst and has road frontage in the hamlet of Dial Green. There are no Rights of Way or footpaths crossing the land and most of the boundaries are well fenced. There is an abundance of wildlife, beautiful walks and tracks through the woodland and at the lower level are ponds and a lake fed by a fast flowing stream, along with a man made waterfall which needs maintenance.

Although in need of some management, the woodland is suitable for a variety of hobbies and pursuits. There are no structures on the land, although there are the remnants of a fishing hut. There is no planning history of note on the land and there is a presumption against development, as it is outside any Settlement Areas and within the South Downs National Park. Historically there was a license to a local fishing club, but we understand that has now expired.



SITUATION

Lying within the South Downs National Park in the area known as the Golden Triangle, Lurgashall is centred around the cricket green and village pub. There is a community run village shop with post office on the green and nearby Northchapel provides shops for most day to day needs. More comprehensive facilities can be found in Petworth, Midhurst and Haslemere. Haslemere main line station provides a fast and frequent service into London Waterloo from 49 minutes and the A286 and A283 provide local road links. There are excellent recreational facilities in the area including polo and golf at Cowdray Park, racing at Goodwood and Fontwell and sailing at Chichester.

FURTHER INFORMATION

There is no planning history of note on the land and there is a presumption against development, as it is outside any Settlement Areas and within the South Downs National Park.

Historically there was a license to a local fishing club, but we understand that has now expired.
